AIM OF THE COURSE

The Online Intensive Course organized by Sapienza University intends to develop professional skills and theoretical knowledge on the issues of the Women, Peace and Security Agenda and its connection with the Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development. The Course is included in the context of the project **"Sapienza TEC: Training, Empowerment and Communication**", carried on with the support of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation as part of the activities of the Forth National Actions Plan aimed at implementing the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325 (2000).

The aim of the Course is to bring more conceptual clarity on the issues of the "Women, Peace and Security" Agenda and its theoretic as well as practical connections with the Agenda 2030.

The objective of the Intensive Online Course is to provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to protect women's rights and to spread the culture of women's empowerment and gender mainstreaming.

The approach will be multidisciplinary and will provide at the same time knowledge on a wide range of relevant legal provisions, academic debates, and case studies. The Course will articulate/address how the 4 pillar of the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325 (2000) had influenced the following WPS Agenda and its implementation by States. More generally, the Course will be focused on the implementation at national level of the WPS Agenda with a critical and practical analysis of the existing obstacles for its implementation.

The Course also delves into the issues of the so-called gender-gap, with specific focus on the concrete actions to be taken in order to overcome the persisting conceptual and cultural obstacles and to promote women's empowerment even in traditional contexts where women are under-estimates or under-represented.

MODALITY OF THE ONLINE INTENSIVE COURSE

The Course will be offered in **English** held in **remote modality** on the **Google Classroom platform**. This platform allows the participation of students, professionals, lawyers, and anyone interested in the issues of the WPS Agenda despite the physical presence at University. The post-meridian time will allow people to join despite possible different time zones and working impediments.

STRUCTURE OF THE ONLINE INTENSIVE COURSE

The Course is divided into 2 modules.

The first module is focused on the **WPS Agenda: the current challenges in achieving a** *full, equal, and meaningful implementation,* with a general overview on the WPS Agenda.

The second module will deepen into the *interactions between the WPS and the 2030 Agendas: different paths for common goals*.

Each module will take a theoretical and practical approach, as well as include case studies and working group in order to encourage the maximum possible interaction.

Lessons will be held by national and international professors, researchers, experts, and practitioners in the field of women's empowerment and gender issues.

The intensive online course is 20 hours in total. It will cover 10 days, with lessons of 2 hours per day. At the end of each module, a **seminar** will take place with international speakers and professionals. For dates and time, see the **programme attached**.

CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION

Certificates of participation will be provided at the end of the Course to participants who have attended at least the 75% of lessons.
